Williams Creek Management has successfully completed miles of stream and riverbank stabilization, restoration, and relocations. The use of a combination of native vegetation with erosion control practices allows for a more ecologically and aesthetically pleasing shoreline. Planting native vegetation along shorelines proves to be more beneficial than just aesthetic looks. Williams Creek Management provided stream mitigation construction services for the Ambria Subdivision. Natural Resource construction services provided include:

- Finish Grading
- Installation of 9,045 square feet of native wet meadow seed mix
- Installation of 1/2 ton of straw mulch
- Installation of 28 - 1 gallon native trees
- Installation of 20 - 1 gallon native shrubs
- Installation of 240 square yards of erosion control blankets
- Installation of 2 sediment markers
- Installation of 8 tons of river cobble
