Prescribed burning is an important management tool for maintaining and enhancing grasslands for longterm preservation. Williams Creek Management assists clients with extensive experience and expertise on various prescribed burning projects.

Williams Creek Management creates a burn plan, which includes discussion with local authorities, obtaining any required permits, and observing all restrictions and safety procedures. Safety procedures include burning on a day with light wind and relatively low humidity when vegetation is dry. Williams Creek Management also determines the right time to burn according to the plants which will be benefited and controlled and the impact on wildlife species.

- Williams Creek Management provides bi-annual Preservation and Maintenance services for 10 acres of prairie located at AmeriPlex.
- 13 prairie sites located at AmeriPlex-Indianapolis have been burned bi-annually in accordance with the United States Geological Survey (USGS) prescribed burning guidelines since 2004.
- Williams Creek Management also provides invasive species control services ensuring prairie restoration will reach its maximum potential.
- Williams Creek Management mowed existing berm and sprayed all unwanted, invasive vegetation with a broadcasted herbicide application. Williams Creek Management then installed native upland prairie seed to restore the berm to the desired condition.
- Restored native vegetation along an existing buffer by installing native prairie seed and providing maintenance services on all native landscaping installation areas.
