Williams Creek Management provided design/build services for the creation of Liberty Park in Westfield, Indiana. Liberty Park was developed to provide a restored floodplain and wetland area within the Cool Creek watershed while generating the opportunity for passive recreation and education. Liberty Park was funded by a local developer due to federally regulated wetland impacts, and has provided the opportunity for regional water quality improvement within the impaired waterway. Services provided by Williams Creek Management include wetland mitigation construction, boardwalk and observation deck installation, and native prairie installation at the site located in Hamilton County, Indiana. Additional services:

- Earthwork: Field staking, construction entrance, excavation, hauling, agri-drain, gabion baskets, and stone
- Installation of 47,920 square feet of tall profile prairie seed mix
- Installation of 59,200 square feet of sedge meadow seed mix
- Installation of 24,000 square feet of emergent seed mix
- Installation of 4,720 square yards of erosion control blankets
- Installation of 25 - 1.5" dbh native trees
- Installation of 5 - 3" dbh native trees
- Installation of 47 - 3 gallon native shrubs
- Construction oversight
