Williams Creek Management provided specialty natural resource installation services for a natural system stormwater Best Management Practice for an expanded automotive facility located in both Hamilton and Boone Counties, Indiana. The purpose of the project was to demonstrate "end of pipe" water quality management utilizing three constructed wetlands in series in one stormwater basin. The project earned its sister company, Williams Creek Consulting, an Indiana Association for Floodplain and Stormwater Management Outstanding Stormwater Project Award. Specific services provided include:

- Finish grading
- Installation of 27,800 square feet of wet to mesic seed mix
- Installation of 29,900 square feet of mesic to dry seed mix
- Installation of 7,360 square yards of erosion control blankets
- Installation of 410 cubic yards of compost mulch
- Installation of 106 - 1.5 caliper native trees
- Installation of 29 shrubs
- Installation of 2,800 wetland and sedge plugs
