Since 2006, Williams Creek has been involved with the Parkview Regional Medical Center as the health care provider in Fort Wayne, Indiana continues to expand its 260 acre campus. Williams Creek has implemented Low Impact Development approach throughout the site, allowing for placemaking through stormwater management while furthering Parkview's sustainability commitments.



Williams Creek has provided professional installation and preservation services for the many constructed wetland basins, vegetated swales, wet ponds and rain gardens throughout the site. These Green Infrastructure (GI) elements manage stormwater while providing aesthetic entrances to the overall site, improve pedestrian circulation and increase wildlife habitat. Stormwater management areas incorporated native woody and herbaceous planting and a paved pedestrian path.



A total of 120,000 live plants were installed throughout these areas. Following the establishment period, Williams Creek has provided preservation services to Parkview as a leader in green infrastructure maintenance to preserve the aesthetic and functional quality of the system.
